Every effort will be made to minimize any duplicity; however, we cannot guarantee exclusivity. In an effort to maximize your success and the success of the Farmers' Market, we will approve product with the intent of having the most variety.

Vendors are responsible for their own clean up or they will be assessed a \$100.00 cleaning fee. Vendors must also read and sign rules and regulations.

Make check payable to the Downtown Improvement Board, or call 785-2554 with a Visa or Mastercard number for payment.

Downtown Farmers Market Rules and Regulations

1. The market will operate from 8:00 am until 12 noon. Booths must be ready at 8:00 am and cannot be taken down until 12 noon.
2. All vendors must fill out an application and receive approval in advance.
3. Vendors selling prepared foods (baked, jarred, cooked items as example) must display occupational licenses and follow state health requirements.
4. Exclusivity of a product cannot be guaranteed, although all efforts will be made to prevent duplication.
5. Vendors will be limited to the sale of plants, bakery, produce, dry goods, consumable items, related items sold by Farmers Market vendors and seasonal items. The sale of antiques, retail flea market and crafts (other than for use with food) will not be permitted.
6. No refunds will be given for non-attendance. If the event is called off in its entirety, refunds may be available.
7. Each vendor is responsible for their own clean up. Any space not left clean or discards not picked up will result in a \$100.00 clean-up fee invoiced to the vendor.
8. Fees are for space only. Booth space is \$25.00, \$30.00 with electricity. Tents, tables and chairs are available for rental, or are the vendor's own responsibility.
9. Payment must be made to the Downtown Improvement Board and can be made with credit cards, debit cards and checks.
10. Violation of the rules may result in being banned from participating in further events.

The below signed vendor hereby agrees to indemnify and hold harmless the City of Panama City, the Panama City Downtown Improvement Board and it's successors, agents and assigns, all persons, firms or corporations, from any and all suits of any kind or nature whatsoever, and particularly on account of injuries, both to person and property which may result from the use of streets, parks and public or private property in Panama City, Florida during the before mentioned event.
